## **Hello Parents. Welcome to Third Grade!!**

Third Grade is a milestone. It is the transition level from primary to upper elementary grades. In third grade your students will mature, develop their styles and skills, and heighten their academics. We are delighted to teach them in this process. Mr. Frazier and I are committed to encouraging your students and nurturing their success and achievement.

We are the Amazing Allstars. In the mornings Mr. Frazier will guide learnings in PE, Science, Social Studies and Spelling. In the afternoons I will be teaching Reading, Bible, Math and Language Arts. Through Reading we will travel through worlds of fiction and fantasy. In writing we will construct paragraphs, essays and book summaries. Through mathematics we will secure our understanding of arithmetic, fractions, solving equations, making change and telling time in analog and digital terms.

Each week parents will receive an electronic bulletin announcing major curriculum objectives for the week. Parents can help support students by checking their homework, holding high expectations for what students can achieve and teaching responsibility and self-discipline. We trust parents to encourage daily reading, monitor behavior and praise the Allstars for doing their best. Parents should discuss the contents of the Weeklies with their students and review the completed work students bring home.

### ***This Week!***

In Reading we will continue decoding our first chapter book, Swiss Family Robinson. Your students will read aloud, silently, in pairs and in groups. They will complete reading logs in class. Ask them about their favorite characters, and to make predictions about what will happen next.

In Math we will introduce our new workbook and continue review of addition and time telling. Students completed a short mathematics assessment on addition and subtraction last week. We will use that information as we continue completing pages 1-10 of the book. Expect one homework page of mathematics per day.

In Language Arts we will start with punctuation and constructing our Who Am I Posters. Students will receive their Language Arts books which will be used largely as a classroom text. This week students will have one language page for homework on Wednesday or Thursday.

In Bible we do an orientation to the Word's format. Students will review the table of contents for both Old and New Testament. They will learn how to use the table of contents as a resource and to understand concepts of chapter and verse. Students will complete pages 1-5 of the Bible Workbook.

Generally, students will have math homework daily and occasionally they will have homework in reading, writing or language Arts. This week parents should review the classroom rules with students and ensure students fully understand the meaning.
